WHAT DOES NORTH EAST WELCH FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information may include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances, transaction history, checking account information
- Assets, credit history, and payment history

When you close your account or are no longer a member, we continue to share information according to this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business- to process transactions, maintain member accounts, and report to credit bureaus. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons North East Welch Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.
